Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we enter into the winter season and the month of December, I want to begin by expressing thanks to all of you for your continued vigilance and support as we monitor signs and symptoms, conduct testing regimes and endure periods of isolation due to many viruses and bugs going around all schools at this time. Please continue to maintain contact with school informing us if your child is unwell, and what is causing their sickness. Please be reminded that the common diarrhoea and vomiting bug requires a period of 48 hours from the last episode before sending your child back to school thus ensuring that staff and pupils are protected from the spread of this bug.

In order to allow the children to enjoy the giving and receiving of cards, I ask that all pupils who wish to give cards, bring them to school beginning Monday 6th December through to Tuesday 21st December. - P4/5, P5, P6 and P7.



Traffic Management, morning arrival and home time

Please continue to be mindful of safety in our school carpark by reducing your speed to 5 mph and manoeuvring with caution whilst on school premises. The Board of Governors continue to press EA on the works which are proposed to control the flow of traffic as well as increase car parking spaces.

Arrival to school in the morning is between $8.45 \, \mathrm{am} - 9.05 \, \mathrm{am}$. There is a 5 minute window for the entry of classes into school until 9.10 am. After 9.10 am, registers are taken and your child will be marked as late if they arrive after this time. It is important that children arrive to school on time to enable their school day to begin with their peers. If your child repeatedly arrives late to school in the morning, you will be contacted to discuss reasons why.

An increasing number of children are walking from school for collection by parents at another location. Please ensure that the class teacher is aware of these arrangements and that children walking, adhere to strict Road safety guidance and behaviour when leaving the school premises.
